

Guide to read the report

"Environmental Oil Spill Sensitivity Atlas for the West Greenland Coastal Zone"

The report is distributed in PDF-format which means that Acrobat Reader must be installed on the computer on which the report is read.

Please see Acrobat Reader's online help for general help on using Acrobat Reader. Concerning this report in particular the following information may help you:

- All links are marked with a thin blue border rectangle.
- The Report is not distributed as one big file but is divided into approx. 300 separate files (of which 140 is air photos). All these files are linked together. Although each file can be read separately it is recommended to start the reading process in ATLAS.PDF and navigate from here to the desired portion of the report.
- The file ATLAS.PDF is the central document from which there are links to all chapters and sections of the report. This file contains links from the tables of contents as well as bookmarks pointing to same locations. Also, the logical structure of the report, title page and datasheet can be seen in this file. Please note that the bookmarks can be expanded and shrunken. Another file: CONTENTS.PDF contains the same bookmarks as ATLAS.PDF but no other text. This file is quicker to open and should be your main navigation tool to all parts of the report.
- All pages in all files contains a link in the upper right corner of the page pointing to CONTENTS.PDF. This link contains the word "Contents". Where relevant links pointing to keymaps and legends are also present.
- On the bottom of the last page in each separate document (chapter or section of chapter) to links are present, pointing to Contents and the first page in the next chapter or section.
- Chapter 9 contains the operational maps and each map and its associated text is a separate document. Each document starts with the "Shoreline Sensitivity Map" and ends with the "Physical Environment & Logistics Map". A link on top of the page links from one map to the other. The pages between the two maps contains the associated text. The text-section "Shoreline sensitivity summary" contains links to more detailed information about each area in Appendix A (Chapter 11)
- Besides from using links and bookmarks to navigate use the button "Go to Previous View" in the Acrobat Reader buttonbar to bring you one step backwards.
